Conditions to applicant for Best Teacher Award at UAS, Raichur

1. The teachers of UAS, Raichur scoring either in teaching, research or extension involved in teaching in last five years are eligible to apply.
2. The teachers who were awarded best teacher once previously or afresh will not be eligible for the same award
3. The teachers who are nominated for the award should not have any pending enquiries or should not have been imposed any major or minor punishments.
4. The teachers have to attach work done certificate by the competent authority wherever applicable

Selection procedure:

1. Teacher who score > 50 marks will be selected based on bio-data
2. The AER marks for the selected candidates are added and merit list is prepared. From the list prepared top five teachers will be selected.
3. The top five teachers will be evaluated by students with 15 marks based on the courses offered by them. Among those, top three will be selected for presentation.
4. Those three teachers will be asked for presentation before a committee and will be evaluated for 10 marks.
5. The teacher scoring highest will be considered for the best teacher award.
